The Northern New England chapter of the Society for Industrial Archeology invites proposals for papers to be presented at the 37th Conference on New England Industrial Archeology. The conference is alternately hosted by the Southern New England and Northern New England chapters as a forum for presenting research of our industrial past. The conference is to be held at the McAuliff-Shepard Discovery Center in Concord, N.H. on Saturday, March 28th.

Papers are welcome on all topics related to industrial history, archeology, manufacturing, preservation, engineering, architecture, etc. in New England and elsewhere. Proposals may be submitted for individual papers, team papers, or reports of works-in-progress. The time limit for each presenter will be 30 minutes with 10 minutes for questions. Student papers are welcome.

FORMAT: Each presenter paper must include:

1) Title, 2) An abstract of not more than 300 words, 3) A brief resume of the author(s), including postal address, e-mail and telephone number, 4) a list of presenters audio-visual requirements.
